

ACCEPTABLE CLOTHING STANDARDS

Effective May 13th, 2024 all employees (including temps) are expected to wear clothing appropriate for the nature of our business and the type of work performed. Clothing should be neat, clean and tasteful. Avoid clothing that can create a safety hazard. If you are not complying with the acceptable clothing standards set below you will be asked to go home.

Acceptable Clothing:

1. Jeans (neat and clean with no holes);
2. T-shirts – that do not display any offensive meaning or advertising (beer, cigarettes, etc.).
3. **Shirts must have a sleeve!**

Unacceptable Clothing includes but is not limited to:

1. Shorts, and bare midriffs, tank tops, and halter tops;
2. **NO LEGGINGS of any kind! (Applies to office staff as well)**
3. Ripped or torn clothing.
4. No skirts/dresses in the production area.
5. No sagging shorts or pants. NO BASKETBALL SHORTS.
